

# **Lesson Payment & Refund Policy**

#### Purpose

The Birdie Club UAE is committed to providing a fair, professional, and enjoyable environment for all members. This policy outlines the payment and refund policy for lessons to ensure clarity, fairness for all.

## **Payment Method**

- All payments must be made through the official Birdie Club website: <u>thebirdieclubuae.com</u>.
- Payments are received in AED. Both local and international card payments are accepted.
- Full or partial payment is required to secure your place in lessons with The Birdie Club.
- Payment links can be generated and shared directly with existing members. Payment must be received within the specified time-frame provided. Failure to complete payment within this time-frame will result in your space being cancelled.

## **Payment Plans**

- **New members:** Full payment is required at the time of booking. Payment plans are not available for new members.
- **Existing members:** Lessons may be paid in up to two instalments, arranged directly with The Birdie Club. Full payment must be received no later than the date provided.

#### Payment breakdown

• Payments for lessons cover the lesson programme fees and applicable transaction charges.

## **Lesson Refund Policy**

Please note that once payment has been received for lessons with The Birdie Club, it is **non-refundable** and **may not** be transferred to any future programme.











The booking may be transferred to another individual, provided they are not already registered with The Birdie Club (applicable to both venues).

#### **Bereavement and Medical Exceptions**

Lessons are non-refundable; however, exceptions may be considered in special circumstances.

- If you are unable to attend due to medical reasons, a valid medical note must be provided.
- In the event of family bereavement, please notify The Birdie Club as soon as possible.
